Phoenix, Arizona – History will be made on Sunday at Super Bowl LVII as it will be the first time that the two starting quarterbacks are Black. Philadelphia Eagles quarterback Jalen Hurts discussed the significance of the historic clash Sunday and what it means to football players of all ages and their fans. "It can be done," Hurts asserted. "Obviously being part of something so historic and making history. You talk about breaking records and being the first to do this, but I think this is something on a whole different level. A whole different magnitude holds a different type of weight."
